CALL FOR ERASMUS+ OUTGOING SHORT STUDENT MOBILITIES BLENDED INTENSIVE PROGRAMME

Critical Issues in International Business and Entrepreneurship academic year 2023/24

In the framework of the Erasmus+ Programme – KA131 Learning Mobility of Individuals, and on the basis of the results and the funds awarded under the project Erasmus 2023-1-IT02-KA131-HED-000135746, a call for **students' selection** is published to assign contributions to take part into the **BLENDED INTENSIVE PROGRAMME named** *Critical Issues in International Business and Entrepreneurship - Anticipating Global Challenges Managerially and Entrepreneurially* hereafter referred to as "BIP".

The purpose of this course is to allow the students develop an overview to recent theory but also to relevant challenges and global concerns. The course combines economic, social and environmental sustainability aspects and the UN SDGs with managerial and entrepreneurial issues on international business triggering the students to rethink and critically address ways forwards. Students develop skills and competences to tackle complex real-life problems in collaboration with others while facilitating their entrepreneurial mindsets and sense of purpose. The variety of theory application settings develops global mindsets and fosters students' sensitivity on diverse aspects international business.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

Applicants must fulfil the following compulsory criteria:

- To be duly enrolled at the University of Pavia for the entire duration of the mobility;
- To possess a proficiency in English language of at least a level of CEFR (Common European Framework of Reference for Languages). Students will be required to communicate and discuss fluently in English, take part in group activities and in general to treat any topic with ease.

1. DETAILS ABOUT THE MOBILITY

The BIP will take place online on July, 1st 2024 and in presence at the LUT University, Finland, **from 24**th **– 28th June** (both included). The course will be considered completed and funded only if the participants will attend the full programme of the entire online part and of the 5 training days in presence.

The **LUT University** will provide the students with a certificate of attendance including the total number of hours attended together with the topics treated and the number of ECTS obtained (3).





2. MOBILITY GRANTS

- The mobility grant includes subsistence for a maximum of 7 days; 5 (five) full days of training + 2 (two) days of travelling, immediately before and after the beginning and finishing date of the course;
- The subsistence sum is 79,00 € per day per student (553,00€), aiming at covering travel, accommodation and meals costs.
- Mobility grants will be paid by the University of Pavia, after the beginning of the mobility in presence, provided that the participant has attended the Blended Intensive programme school for its entire duration and they are able to provide travel documents (e.g. boarding passes). The grant must be refunded in case the student will not be able to join the mobility its entire duration (physical + virtual);
- The mobility grant is a fixed amount of money that cannot be incremented under any circumstances;
- The University of Pavia will provide its outgoing students with insurance covering accidents, civil liability and other guarantees in accordance with its internal procedures.

3. ONLINE APPLICATION AND DEADLINE

The applicant is required to complete the online application form at the following link by the 20/05/2024 at 12:00 CET - noon.

4. EVALUATION AND SELECTION

The selection will be made by a joint Committee established within the Department of Business and Economics headed by the Professor in charge of the BIP for the University of Pavia (Prof. Birgit Hagen).

The following criteria will be taken into consideration:

- The motivation letter:
- Relevance with study program.

In case of equal evaluation between two candidates, the Evaluation Commission reserves the right to give priority to those applications which add to the diversity of the study programme in terms of gender balance, year of study, and variety of mobility experience.

The Committee reserves the right to check the validity of declarations and supporting documents. False statements may lead to exclusion from the selection process and the award of the scholarship.

Each applicant will be notified about selection results and the grant in due time, via the email address provided in the application.

Selected applicants must then officially accept the awarded grant by answering via email.





5. PERSONAL DATA TREATMENT

Personal data submitted by the applicants will be used solely for application and selection procedures and institutional aims, and will be treated in accordance with the European General Data Protection Regulation no. 2016/679 art. 13.
