Call for applications for the award of tuition fee waivers for University of Pavia's Foundation Year students enrolling at the University of Pavia in the academic year 2024/25

ART. 1 - Beneficiaries, amount and duration

In order to encourage Foundation Year students of the University of Pavia to enroll at our University, 29 tuition fee waivers will be awarded on a "First come first served" basis to students enrolling in non-restricted access Bachelor's and Single-cycle Master's degree programs for academic year 2024/25.

The holder of the fee waiver will only pay the tuition fee installment that covers a regional tax for the right to higher education and a duty stamp (for a total of 156 euros).

The fee waiver is effective for the first year only and cannot be extended or renewed.

ART. 2 - Requirements

The applicants must fulfill all the following conditions:

- 1. Be enrolled in the Foundation Year of the University of Pavia for academic year 2023/24.
- 2. Enroll in a non-restricted access Bachelor's/Single-cycle degree program at the University of Pavia for academic year 2024/25, paying the tuition fee installment that covers the regional tax and the duty stamp (156 euros) from 15th May to 30th June 2024. Please, check Attachment 1 for the eligible degree programs.

ART. 3 - Award of tuition fee waivers

The award of the tuition fee waivers will be made on a "First come, first served" basis, considering the chronological order of the 156 euros installment payment.

The winners will be notified by email within 5th July 2024.

In case of residual fee waivers, info will be provided at this link

ATTENTION: The fee waivers will be awarded only to Foundation Year students who will successfully pass the program's final exam in June 2024.

ART. 4 - Incompatibility

Tuition fee waivers are **not compatible** with:

- Any other kind of scholarship/grant issued by the University of Pavia;
- EDiSU Pavia scholarship:
 - Students who apply for a fee waiver can also apply for EDiSU scholarship via a call that is published in July every year (see www.edisu.pv.it). As the fee waiver is already included in the EDiSU scholarship, EDiSU scholarship winners will automatically lose the fee waiver offered by this call;



- Any grant issued by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation (MAECI);
- Any grant issued under a Multiple or Joint degree program, or for which tuition fees must be paid to a partner University other than the University of Pavia.

ART. 6 - Personal data treatment

Personal data submitted by the applicants will be used solely for application procedures and institutional purposes, and will be treated in accordance with the European General Data Protection Regulation no.2016/679 art.13.
