CALL FOR EXPRESSION OF INTEREST FOR THE IDENTIFICATION OF STUDENTS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF PAVIA INTERESTED IN PARTICIPATING IN THE EXPERIMENTAL PROJECT "CO-HOUSING AND CARING BETWEEN GENERATIONS" - INTERGENERATIONAL EXCHANGE MEASURES TO SUPPORT THE INCLUSION OF THE ELDERLY POPULATION

1. PREMISE

The purpose of this notice is to explore the interest of students enrolled at the University of Pavia (academic year 2024/2025), interested in participating in the experimental project "Co-Housing and Caring between generations" – Intergenerational exchange measures to support the inclusion of the elderly population, as better represented in point 2 of this document.

Adherence to this notice does not constitute a commitment for the parties to finalize the action for which their interest has been expressed but is aimed at better defining the scope of interest in order to finalize the generational meeting.

2. SUBJECT OF THE CALL

The Project involves the development of two actions:

a) CO-HABITATION: Cohabitation and intergenerational cohabitation between students and people over 65.

This is an action aimed at promoting an alliance between the student population and the citizens of Pavia over-65. It is not a welfare-type relationship, but rather an intergenerational pact aimed at promoting supportive relationships starting from a regular rental contract (cohabitation as a form of active inclusion).

The University of Pavia identifies in this intergenerational pact the opportunity to combine an action to support integration between the student population and over-65s with a strategy capable of responding to the increase in requests for rental at sustainable costs by out-of-town students.

The balance between housing supply and demand has generated a significant increase in prices and in any case an insufficient availability of housing which is intended to be addressed also with innovative solutions such as "intergenerational cohabitation".

In addition to a "cohabitation agreement", the provision by the student of additional services is envisaged, based on the student's profiled skills and the needs of people over65 (e.g. use of IT resources, such as SPID; facilitation of access to healthcare; accompaniment to administrative structures; moments of socialization and leisure,...), and it is also intended to promote a new style of living that guarantees young and old people a better quality of life and a fight against loneliness through the sharing of relational goods.

The rental contract is defined with the advice of the sector associations that adhere to the project that will follow the process and provides for a definition of costs that takes into account the actual space and services available to the hosted person.

The accommodations may also be in neighboring municipalities.

The University will contribute to the rent for a quota of up to a maximum of 300 euros per student.

b) GENERATIONAL SUPPORT: relationships and services of students to support people over 65.

This is an action aimed at offering the elderly over 65 support services aimed at creating healthy relationships of friendship and solidarity, based on volunteering guaranteed by university students, not necessarily in cohabitation situations.

These activities include forms of meeting, listening and information organized at the University, on topics of interest for the over 65s, such as:

- Film festivals (cineforum) at the University cinema-auditorium
- Musical evenings animated by student musicians
- Scientific dissemination events led by doctoral students
- Days for the promotion of the health of the elderly
- Visit to the University museums and exhibitions
- Visit to the green areas and the Botanical Garden
- Wellness and fitness paths (University sports and leisure facilities)
- Days dedicated to the intergenerational transmission of life memories.

Furthermore, at the University, thanks to the presence and possibility of using equipped rooms with spaces reserved for study, the student will be able to support and train the person over 65 for:

- Use of technological and IT tools (mobile telephone devices, PCs, tablets)
- Conversations in a foreign language with foreign students
- Reading texts.

The two actions are not mutually exclusive. The interested student can express their interest in one of the two actions or in both.

The students participating in the project will be recognized elective or additional university training credits within the individual study plans in relation to the activities carried out in support of the elderly and/or Open Badges.

3. RECIPIENTS OF THE INTERVENTION – PARTICIPATION REQUIREMENTS

Those who are eligible for the benefit referred to in point 2.a “CO-HABITATION: Intergenerational cohabitation and cohabitation between students and people over 65” are:

- Students regularly **enrolled at the University of Pavia for the academic year 2024/2025**, aged between 18 and 32, usefully included in the EDISU rankings for access to the measures of the right to university education, but not beneficiaries of beds or scholarships;
- **residents in a city other than the one where the property rented for the purposes of university studies is located;**
- **students with a good knowledge of spoken Italian;**

Those who are eligible for the benefit referred to in point 2.b “GENERATIONAL SUPPORT: student relations and services in support of people over 65” are:

- **students regularly enrolled at the University of Pavia for the academic year 2024/2025.**

4. HOW TO PARTICIPATE

Interested students who meet the requirements set out in point 3 must submit the request by completing the attached form and sending it to **over65@unipv.it** by **15 October 2024**, along with

all the documentation requested therein.

It is requested to specify in the subject of the email the name of the project "CO-HOUSING E CARING" and the action to which you are applying, for example:

"Name Surname – CO-HOUSING E CARING – application for action a".

Students whose applications lack, totally or partially, the data and documentation required or whose participation requirements cannot be ascertained will not be admitted to the selection.

5. IDENTIFICATION OF ELIGIBLE PARTIES AND DEFINITION OF THE AMOUNT OF CONTRIBUTIONS

The University of Pavia, having carried out the necessary checks and verifications, will proceed with an interview with the interested student, aimed at ascertaining motivations and requirements, based on the order of submission of the application for admission.

Students will be admitted until the maximum number of available accommodations/shares is reached.

6. CONSEQUENCES IN THE EVENT OF CONFIRMED UNTRUTHINESS OF THE STATEMENTS MADE

In the event of the discovery of untrue statements regarding self-certifications produced by students who will be beneficiaries of the contribution subject of the notice, the sanctions provided for by articles no. 75 and no. 76 of Presidential Decree 445/2000 may be applied in addition to the revocation of the benefit granted. The adoption of disciplinary sanctions and reporting to the judicial authority is reserved if the extremes of a crime are identified.

7. EXCLUSIVE FORUM

For any dispute relating to this notice, or arising from its application, the competent court is that of Pavia.

8. INFORMATION ON THE USE OF PERSONAL DATA AND ON THE RIGHTS OF THE DECLARANT (pursuant to and for the purposes of art. 13 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 (GDPR) and art. 13 of Legislative Decree 30/06/2003 n. 196)

The personal data that will be collected by the University of Pavia with the application to participate in this call will be processed in compliance with the principles of EU Regulation n. 2016/679 and Legislative Decree n. 196 of 2003, as subsequently amended, as well as according to the methods, purposes and limits indicated in the information document available online, before submitting the application.
